Field cleanup after all practices (making sure all equipment is stored and picking up all trash)

Participation in all Fundraising Events

 \Box Field setup for all Bearcat home games (must be able to arrive early before first game then setup field for upper level games)

Field cleanup after all home games have ended (picking up trash and putting in the dumpster, tearing down concessions, etc.)

□Volunteer to assist with Bearcats Camps setting up and breaking down each day (this also can include bringing ice/water and snacks)

Uniform and equipment preparation, distribution, and year of season equipment collection (*this also includes helping to move equipment at the beginning of the season and at the end of the season from one storage location to McCallum*)
