



Revere Baseball Softball Association Graduating Senior Scholarship

The Revere Baseball Softball Association's (RBSA) Graduating Senior Scholarship will be awarded to one baseball and one softball player graduating from Revere High School that meet the scholarship requirements. The winner will receive a one-time gift of \$500 from RBSA. The winning baseball and softball player will be required to fill out an application, provide responses to two essay questions, and be accepted and plan to attend any post high school academic program. Applicants must provide a completed application, essays, and proof of acceptance to a post high school academic program by April 30th of their high school graduation year.

RBSA Background

The purpose of RBSA is to promote, organize, administer, and implement quality baseball and softball programs for the youth residing in the Revere School District.

The RBSA Graduating Senior Scholarship is established to aid students who are continuing their education at a 2- or 4-year college or university, or a trade school. Payments will be made directly to the school in the student's name. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Graduating senior currently enrolled in the Revere School District.
- Played a minimum of 4 seasons within the RBSA baseball or softball program (recreation, travel or a combination of both programs).
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 through the end of the fall semester of the senior year.
- Current member of the Revere High School baseball or softball team.
- Acceptance to and intention to attend a 2- or 4-year college or university, or a trade school.
