

INVITATION TO THE 2017 PONY BASEBALL 8U COACH PITCH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The tournament will be a 16 Team Pool Play Seeding Tournament followed by a Single Elimination Tournament to crown the 8U PONY NATIONAL CHAMPION.

There will be 4 Pools of 4 TEAMS EACH

THIS FORMAT WILL GIVE EACH TEAMS 3 GAMES DURING THIS ROUND OF POOL PLAY. A MINIMUM OF TWO GAMES IN THE NEXT 2 ROUNDS OF PLAY WILL GIVE EVERY TEAM A TOTAL OF AT LEAST 5 GAMES.

Once Pool Play is finished we will seed the teams in each pool to give them a NEW Ranking within their pool. A1, A2, A3, ETC.

The teams are seeded by:

Best Record

Head to Head

Runs Allowed

Runs Scored

If still tied, that tie will be broken with a coin toss.

Once all the teams have been seeded they will play a Single Elimination Tournament

Based upon the pool seeding the teams are placed in a single elimination tournament bracket as follows:

Game 1 A1 VS D4

Game 2 C2 VS B3

Game 3 B2 VS A3

Game 4 D1 VS A4

Game 5 C1 VS B4

Game 6 D3 VS A2

Game 7 D2 VS C3

Game 8 B1 VS C4

This gives you the 4 pairings for the 8 Team Single Elimination Bracket to Crown the 8U PONY NATIONAL CHAMPION.

We are planning on having teams from across the country to play in this tournament. Mt. Vernon is in the southern part of the state of Illinois and is easy driving distance from St. Louis, Missouri and Evansville, Indiana. Chicago, IL is approximately four hours north of Mt. Vernon. Mt. Vernon, IL has two major Interstates that intersect the city, I 57 and I 64. Interstate I 24 is only 50 miles south of Mt. Vernon on Interstate I 57. Mt. Vernon has 1227 hotel rooms, over 60 restaurants, and a Water Park near the ball fields.

Mt. Vernon is just minutes from some of the finest outdoor recreation in the Midwest, the Rend Lake Recreation area, that offers a fishing, boating, golfing, and hunting paradise for the outdoor enthusiast.

Cultural offerings in Mt. Vernon include the magnificent Cedarhurst Center for the Arts complex that features the art museum, sculpture park, programs and events including the nationally acclaimed Cedarhurst Craft Fair held each fall on the weekend after Labor Day. The Jefferson County Historical Village offers a look back into the history of the settlers of the area and their lifestyle with authentic log cabins and a museum interpretive center.

Other attractions include the Appellate Courthouse where Abraham Lincoln represented clients, the C. E. Brehm Library with its impressive genealogy collection, plus acres of public parks, golf courses, raceway, winery, and much more.

Marion, Illinois is approximately 40 mile south of Mt. Vernon on Interstate I 57. The city of Marion has many things to offer as well. There are many hotels located in Marion. Marion is also home to the Southern Illinois Miners Baseball Team. The team is part of the Frontier League, and plays at Rent One Park, at the intersection of Interstate I 57 and Rout 13.

St. Louis offers many exciting attractions as well. Come see the St. Louis Arch, the Gateway to the West, Six Flags theme park, Ballpark Village. The St. Louis Zoo, Grant's Farm, and many other attractions. Please visit Mt. Vernon, IL, Marion, IL, and St. Louis, MO web sites for more information about these areas.
