Age Eligibility

PTAA Softball league selection in the spring is by age. Softball league selection in the fall is by grade or age of the player. Age based on the date of birth of the player registering. Grade is based on the grade player is entering during current or upcoming school year.

PTAA Baseball league selection in the spring and fall is by age. For many years PTAA has followed the little league age determination guidelines. Recent changes to these age guidelines have forced the PTAA baseball program to not enforce the revised little league mandates. In 2016 the board voted to **NOT** follow the new little league age changes and keep the original cut off dates for all ages. More info on this change here.

Registration Fees

Registration during the Spring Season is online via credit card or in person usually in February. Fall Season registration is by credit card only. Checks NOT accepted online during registration. If other financial arrangements need to be made please contact ptaa@playptaa.com.

Optional Concession Stand Fee of \$50 selected during registration will cover parents/players who would like to opt out of concession stand duty. We strongly encourage every parent to volunteer to work the stand and not opt out. Fee used to pay an alternate to work in your place. If you choose not to pay fee to work the stand, and not work, PTAA will add fee to your online balance.

Family max discount is not available in the Fall season and/or does not apply to Baseball All-Star, Junior Legion, Baseball Travel, or Softball Tournaments players.

PTAA Refund Policy

The Penn Township Athletic Association has a comprehensive refund policy that we've outlined below: All refund requests must be submitted in writing to either the Director of Baseball or the Director of Softball depending on the division player registered for. Contact info can be found on our Board Members page.

- 100% of registration fee up until player uniforms are ordered (minus a \$5 processing fee)
- 50% refund between uniform orders and season officially starts. Season starts at start of first practice. (minus a \$5 processing fee)
- 0% refund after season officially starts. Season starts at start of first practice.

Refunds will also be issued under the following circumstances subject to review by the board of directors.

- Injury
- Relocation
- Unable to be placed on a team

If the PTAA Organization incurs any fees related to disputes or refunds they will be added to the players account online or final refund amount.

1. Registration Final Message

PTAA is under no obligation to grant special requests for your child to be on a specific team, have a specific coach, or be placed on a team with a specific player other than a sibling, or be re-drafted. Any such request must be made to the BASEBALL or SOFTBALL BOARD and requires board approval. Penn Township Athletic Association also reserves the right to use any photograph/videography taken at any event, sponsored by PTAA, without the expressed written permission of those included within the photograph. Photographs may be used in publications or other media material produced, used or contracted by PTAA including but not limited to: newspapers, magazines, television, websites, etc. Any person desiring not to have their photo taken or distributed must contact the PTAA President in writing

of their intentions and include a photograph. The photo will be used for identification purposes and will be held in confidence by the PTAA organization.

2. Association Release and Consent

I / We, the parent or legal guardian of the registered applicant(s), hereby give my/our approval for his/her participation in any or all association activities during the current year. I/We assume all risk and hazards to and from the activities, and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the "Penn Township Athletic Association" and its sponsors, managers, assistants and umpires for any claim arising out of any injury to the applicant. I/We agree to return uniforms and other equipment belonging to the "Penn Township Athletic Association" in a good as received, less reasonable normal usage.

3. Injury Disclaimer

As a parent, if you think your child or teen may have an injury, you should:

- 1. Remove your child or teen from play.
- 2. Keep your child or teen out of play the day of the injury. Your child or teen should be seen by a healthcare provider and only return to play with permission from a healthcare provider who is experienced in evaluating injuries.
- 3. Ask your child's or teen's healthcare provider for written instructions on helping your child or teen return to play. You can give the return-to-play instructions to your child's or teen's coach.

Do not try to judge the severity of the injury yourself. Only a healthcare provider should assess a child or teen for a possible severe injury. You may not know how serious the injury is at first, and some symptoms may not show up for hours or days. A child's or teen's return to sports should be a gradual process that is carefully managed and monitored by a healthcare provider.
