### Field Permits/Maintenance/Locks

The board discussed the decisions to pull the permits for the Poindexter fields a week earlier to allow for the teams to start practicing earlier and have more time to practice before opening day. Additionally the board discussed the city's offer to potentially help with covering the maintenance of Farm fields. All 5 fields will get work done during winter break to get them ready for spring season.

Permits have been pulled for both the city and the school district – deposit has been made full amount will be paid in January.

The board has rekeyed the fields and the shed at Poindexter and the batting cage at the Poindexter fields. New keys will be passed out o the fields as needed.

# **Registration Update**

The board reviewed the current numbers for registrations. As of December 16th, there are 250 player registered and 30 Managers / 36 Coaches applications submitted. Expecting a rush at the end of December/early January. The board will discuss combining AA and AAA into minors, they will discuss further at the next meeting once registration is closed.

### **Charter and Insurance**

The board reviewed that both Charter and insurance has been paid. New insurance will be provided to the city and school district. As of now the board has chartered 36 teams (T-ball 10, MP 6, Farm 6, AA 4, AAA 2, Majors 4, Juniors 4). The number of team chartered can be changed if the board needs to remove or add teams.

#### Field Maintenance

The board discussed when we should have the field maintenance day, possibly in early February. The board will pick a date and finalize the list of activities in the upcoming meeting.

Opening day is February 22<sup>th</sup>. Opening day Committee will meet after the new year and discuss the framework for opening day, re ceremony, game schedule, activities etc.

### **Field Maintenance**

The board mad a motion to approve the quote for field maintenance – came in at \$13K which was under the original planned budget. The motion was approved.

#### New Fridge

The board has found a new fridge that meets the needed criteria and can be delivered as early as tomorrow. The board made the motion to approve the \$1,750 cost and the motion was approved.

## **Evals – Sign up Genius**

The board discussed that Evals will be available to sign up starting December 20th via sign up genius.

### **Score Keeping Training**

Training will be held prior to opening day. The board discussed ensuring the training highlights that coaches cannot keep score and score keeper keeps score. Reminders also that coaches need to look at the book and sign off on it and it's important to ensure the pitch count needs to be recorded correctly.

# **Selection of Managers**

December 16<sup>th</sup> was the last day to sign up as a manager. However some of the divisions still need additional coaches. With divisions with more managers than number of teams, the Board will vote on a priority list – currently Majors and Juniors will need votes.
