Other Pitching / Catching Restrictions						
A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game, cannot play catcher for the remainder of the day.		ANSLL Local Rules: 1) a minors or majors player who delivers 51 or more pitches in a game must not pitch in the next game his team plays (pitches to finish a batter do not count towards 51). 2) Max pitching age for Juniors is 14.			*A player who plays the position of catcher in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.
