Fall Sports Updates

Girls Volleyball – signup numbers are similar to last season; could use a few more 3rd graders to even out numbers;

Soccer – approx.. 170 players this season; the regular season is wrapping up;
2nd Annual Mary Queen of All Saints Soccer Tournament will be held the weekend of October 29-30 – for teams that do not qualify for the post-season SAY tournament.

Golf – season and post-season tournaments are completed; the first season of fielding a Varsity level team went very well, and the plan is to continue to have a Varsity level team in subsequent years. Six St. Dominic players participated in the Varsity Tournament at Clovernook Country Club; the team finished 5th out of 7 teams. George Goins finished 3rd in the Instructional Division tournament.

Football – The number of St. Dominic players is up three over last season. All four levels (Varsity, Reserve, Pony, and Bandit have St Dominic students on the teams.

Winter Sports

Boys Basketball – Signups ended, and teams, coaches are being notified. Tryouts for 8th Grade A team will take place on October 15 and 22.

Since we did not have enough players in either grade, St. Dominic 5th and 6th graders will play for Our Lady of Victory this season.
