- 5. Old Business:
 - Bylaw Changes

Read last meeting – vote tonight:

Section 8: All-Star selections: must make 75% of regularly scheduled in-house games up to the All Star voting date. Must also need to commit to availability for at least 2 out of 3 of the tournaments. Must be picked for in-house games not Travel league. The Spring Season's Summer All Star teams that were selected through the SFBSA All Star voting process will be the next year's Sunday League travel team. In order to participate in these Sunday League Travel Teams, must also play in-house.

Article XV: Travel Leagues

The travel teams that were selected through the SFBSA All Star voting process will be governed by the SFBSA. The SFBSA will provide field time, insurance and supplies to those travel teams that were SFBSA All Stars the prior year and continue to play together through the next season and play in house. Any events hosted by the SFBSA will also be considered SFBSA sponsored tournaments.

This was read again at meeting and voted upon. Bill motioned to approve, Adam seconded, all board members present agreed. Laura to make updates to bylaws and repost on website.
