• Equipment Update

Catchers equipment will be numbered this year (SF #1) and will be tallied up at equipment return. There were so many catchers mitts not returned last year. Dan will be collecting a deposit from coaches this year for equipment, most likely \$100 and check will be shredded upon return of coaching equipment.

Recommendation to only put 2 helmets max (make sure 1 has facemask) in coaches bags this year; bats aren't used often either.

- Scheduling:
 - New Website Scheduling Scheduling will be done on the Blue Sombrero (new SFBSA website) this year. Easy access for coaches/schedules posted.
 - Dick's Team Headquarter App for Coaches through new website All coaches/parents will get free access to the Dick's Team Headquarters app this year – which is kind of like Team Snap for those familiar – helps to track player attendance and game scheduling, etc. More details to follow once schedule is posted.
