- Code of Conduct Review
 We went over the Code of Conduct and reminded everyone that they accepted this during the registration process. Please be mindful of the Code of Conduct and adhere to this coaches, kids and umpires and doing their best.
- Proposed Bylaw Amendments

Delete last sentence of XII: Manager Responsibilities; Spring Ball; Section 2 regarding Little League Cutoff Date

Section 2: Spring Ball is played at the T-ball level and up to Colt League on the baseball side and 8U Slow Pitch, 10U – 15U slow & fast pitch on the softball side. Spring Ball will follow Little League birthdate cutoff requirements of 04/30 for baseball and 12/31 for softball. We will follow Little League rules regarding any changes to the cut-off date.

Delete Section 3 in same section above as it is not really a bylaw item

Section 3: All Managers should share Spring Ball registration information with their Fall Ball team as it becomes available to remind them of the registration.

Delete Section 3 in Fall Ball Section also as is not really a bylaw item

Section 3: All Managers should share Spring Ball registration information with their spring team as it becomes available to remind them of the registration.

Also in Fall ball Section 2 – make it like spring. Play next year's age....so move around if board discretion

- **Section 2:** Fall Ball is played at the Coach Pitch level and up to Pony League on the baseball side and 8U Slow Pitch, 10U 15U slow & fast pitch on the softball side. Typically for Fall Ball players are should register for where they will be playing in the Spring season (CVC & GPSL Rules require that players play at the level they would in the Spring).
- Article XIV: Player eligibility
- Section 1: Players joining the SFBSA must be a playing age of 5 years of age (this is based on the playing age cut-off date). Boys: April 30th of the upcoming season. Girls: December 31 of the previous year.
 EXCEPTION: Girls that reach age 5 by April 30 of the upcoming season may play tee ball. And girls that reach age 7 by 4/30 of the upcoming season may play 8U softball.

Parents must declare the playing age of their boy or girl at the time of registration and All parents must supply provide the Association with a copy of the child's birth certificate at the time of registration and register to play in the corresponding age level. Parents of children only at age 6 may request approval from the Board to play up in age level as described in Section 2. This age will be the age that the player must play all games that season, including but not limited to regular season, Sunday league, and Tournament/All Star Games.

- **Section 2:** SFBSA encourages requires all players to play in their given age groups. However, once a player is 5 years of age he/she may play in an older age group if approval is granted by the Board of Directors prior to the first scheduled game of the season. However, a player at age 6 years of age may move up to the next division in baseball or softball. No other ages may play up. If a 6 year old moves up, parents must sign a waiver allowing the child to play at the next division; he/she will not be eligible for All Stars as a 6 year old; and he/she will play 3 years at that next level (coach pitch baseball or 8u softball). Approval needs to be granted by the Board of Directors prior to the first scheduled game of the season. A tryout will be made available with at least one Board of Director in attendance for those players looking to move up to evaluate that he/she can play safely at a higher level.
- **Section 3:** Any player granted by Board approval to play in an older age group (referred to as "playing up") MUST PLAY ALL SFBSA approved games at the older age level for that entire season. For example, an age 10 player that is granted Board approval to play at age 11, must play ALL games that season as an age 11 player, including but not limited to regular season, Sunday league, and Tournament/All Star Games.

Township is in the process of developing a fee schedule. As it stands right now, we would be charged \$75 per day for our all star tournaments. ideas with the township about putting a separate shed for outside teams to use when they rent our fields so they are not using the items that we are purchasing.
