



**CLARIFICATION OF LOCAL RULES**  
***Pee Wee Boys***

**March 23, 2023**

***This document is to serve as a local clarification and meant to supplement District 13 Coach pitch rules and regulations.***

- No Inning shall start after 70 minutes of play
- Any Inning started shall be finished

Use a continuous batting order and all fielders may switch as needed provided everyone receives a minimum of 6 outs in the field.

The following guidelines will help keep the games moving as quickly as possible:

- 5:45 - Umpires need to report to the field for pre-game equipment check and coaches' meetings.
- Begin the game as soon as all issues have been taken care of. If it is a few minutes before 6, that is ok. Let's always try to begin by 6 or before. Start the game clock at the conclusion of the coach's meeting
- Reminder -- You may courtesy run for the catcher with 2 outs. (Courtesy runner is who ever made the last out)
- Encourage your team to hustle on and off the field.
- Overthrows at 1<sup>st</sup> base: If a throw is made to first for a force out from any position and the first baseman or coach in field requests "Time" Runners will only be awarded one base for the overthrow. They will only be awarded the base if a commitment is made to take that base and are doing so at their own risk. Any remaining base runners are live. If a play is attempted at another base on the field, the runner may proceed at their own risk.
- If you have less than 9 players, you may start the game and add them to the end of the lineup as they show up without penalty. You may also pickup if mutually agreed by the other team. The player shall bat last and play outfield.

**Additional Items:**

- Everyone will get a box of game balls with their equipment bag
- Typically we will make it through a game with 2 game balls supplied by the home team.

**General Notes:**

Umpire duty is simply representatives from both teams working together for the first half of the season.

GameChanger acts as the official book of record for coach pitch. At minimum, one person should score the head to head match up that is already entered in GameChanger. Errors are to be marked where needed. For example: Homerun on ground ball to pitcher is not possible. This situation would either be an error or a single and reached other bases on other errors. Scoring accurately ensures more accurate batter and team stats.

Home team is also responsible to designate someone to run the scoreboard.

After the game take a few minutes to rake the field and pick up trash

Make up games will be scheduled at the end of the regularly scheduled game and only if needed.

Once a player has played in 8 games, he is All-Star eligible (age permitting)

Begin with all kids on field, defensively. At half way point, change to 9, like normal.

Coaches may be in the field defensively for the first half with all kids in the field.

No Inning will start after 70 minutes, once an inning begins, it gets completed. If home team is batting and has the lead, the game is over
