President:

- 1. Fields are lined at Fairview
- 2. South Fayette is Superbowl Site- Requirement to host coaches meeting and reimbursed at Super Bowl from all proceeds

Flag Representative:

- 2. Need new jerseys for additional registrations. Drafts have occurred except for 3/4th. Looking for fields. Hunting Ridge fields. Pit fields are available starting in October. USC football is in charge of scheduling. SF hosting 2 games at Fairview for flag. Monday nights are available during school year- may offer to host games at Fairview on Monday nights. Treasurer requested refs total. Kirk to send alert to school/Mark Keener and Erin Crimone to circulate the need for refs for Flag Football.

Old Business:

1. By-law change—Jaella proposed a wording change to the bylaw section that addresses "apprentice." The second reading will occur at February's meeting.

New Business:

1) SNACK NIGHT- 2 nights organization wide- 1 Sept and 1 Oct meet at pavilion and all teams will be involved (Kona Ice). More of a grab and go. Have to limit kids on the field. Garbage

- left on the field. Food kept in the parking lot area. Trisha Shelf- deal with Big Guys if 15 ordered, deal on XL pizzas.
- 2) GAME DAY BAGS- No longer doing those. Started in 2020 due to concession stand being closed. No sign up for the concessions.
- 3) CHANGE IN BY-LAWS- Removing combine and optional work-outs. Remove Draft entirely. Splitting teams earlier in July.
- 4) Heat acclimation is mandatory 3 days before heats. Want to offer skills camps through High School.
- 5) South Hills League- does not require Kindergarteners to get 6 plays. SF by-laws require all players 6 plays. Motion to be made to comply SF by-laws with League by-laws. Proposed bylaw read in.
- 6) HUDL- tools for head coaches to utilize. Assists for coaches/players. Slenchek has been using HULD for over a decade. Coaches can create playbook and carry through so that any assistant coach could see the plays. New Coaches have playbooks available. Plays could be designed- and attach video to the play. Assist- evaluating opponents and tendencies. Appx \$200 extra for the playbook. Each team has 24 hours to upload video.
- 7) KONA ICE- Aug 15th. 1 hour of unlimited KONA ICE.
- 8) CHEER SHOWCASE- Aug 28th.
- 9) END OF THE YEAR PARTIES- Try to work on a similar location. Shared Decorations, etc.
- 10) DRAFT- Teams have been picked. Game Changer has been updated and all teams were communicated. No complaints of team selections.
- 11) JV Meeting is at 5:00 at Fairview.
- 12) Varsity Meeting is at 6:00 at Fairview before Practice.
- 13) Varsity practice 6:30-8:30 pm JV and termites 6-8 in August.
- 14) Aug 26- pictures.
- 15) After Labor Day- NO MONDAYS. 3 days per week.
- 16) August 13th is 6th grade orientation. Varsity practices might be moved to later date. Aug 13th Varsity practice will be cancelled.
- 17) DRAFT Concern raised by Kirk Wojno- Friday night occurred. End of JV draft turned into a combative and hostile environment. In a public violation. Felt in violation of Code of Conduct. BWorried that there was a issue in a community event in a public event. President- All are competitive and there are taken out of control. Not the same as a fantasy football draft. SF Organization being held at a higher standard than others. Want to represent the organization. South Hills League- requires no more than 2 differential per grade.
- 18) League needs to know the opt out of 5th quarter by Monday. No hand shakes until 5th quarter. No players are to leave before 5th Quarter.
