President:

- Anthony Lee, seeking volunteer coaching spot: Anthony had the opportunity to speak with the board about continuing his involvement with youth sports. Having started playing football in South Fayette, Anthony has interest in assisting wherever we may need him. Once registration closes and coaching interest is determined, we will place him where we could use additional help.
- Coach Rossi Spring Flag Football Meeting: Registration will be pen and paper and will take place in person on 2 set dates in March in the Community room. Once dates are verified by South Fayette, they will be sent out via email. Details to be determined and sent out. Will include a combine (1 session), followed by weekly Sunday evening skills sessions and games. Will run early April through early June. Steelers will provide equipment, High School Football players will ref, and parents will assist in coaching. Cost will be approximately \$40 per athlete.
