Hi Parents & Players of PTAA,

Due to concerns surrounding the COVID-19/coronavirus pandemic, the PTAA Board of Directors have agreed to temporarily pause the 2020 spring baseball and softball season effective immediately through Friday, March 27th, at which time we will evaluate the situation further.

The PTAA Board is taking this matter very seriously as there is nothing more important than the health and safety of everyone involved in the PTAA programs. In addition, while disappointing, we believe pausing all activities for the next 2 weeks is necessary to help prevent further spread of the disease. 2 weeks is the recommendation from the CDC and the Governor of Pennsylvania.

All events planned during this time we plan to reschedule. DSG shopping day, late registrations, and board meeting cancelled and rescheduled. Coach's orientation and Draft planned for Tuesday next week also cancelled and rescheduled. Any teams under PTAA that have scheduled practices or games indoors or outdoors cancelled.

The PTAA board plans to meet on Sunday to agree on a comprehensive plan for the season. The board will act under the guidance of local, state, and national agencies. We have received emails asking if we will refund and cancel the season. This is a possibility but it is too soon to tell if this will occur or not. As much as we want the season to take place, the health and safety of our members is more important.

We plan to send weekly communications updating you on the plans for the season until we can restart our programs. We hope to get past this quickly and get the spring season started as planned.
