## **Age Eligibility**

PTAA Softball league selection in the spring is by age. Softball league selection in the fall is by grade or age of the player. Age based on the date of birth of the player registering. Grade is based on the grade player is entering during current or upcoming school year.

PTAA Baseball league selection in the spring and fall is by age. For many years PTAA has followed the little league age determination guidelines. Recent changes to these age guidelines have forced the PTAA baseball program to not enforce the revised little league mandates. In 2016 the board voted to **NOT** follow the new little league age changes and keep the original cut off dates for all ages. More info on this change here.

#### **PTAA Refund Policy**

The Penn Township Athletic Association has a comprehensive refund policy that we've outlined below: All refund requests must be submitted in writing to either the Director of Baseball or the Director of Softball depending on the division player registered for. Contact info listed on our Board Members page.

- 100% of registration fee up until player uniforms are ordered (minus a \$5 processing fee/Website service fee is non-refundable)
- 50% refund between uniform orders and season start (minus a \$5 processing fee/Website service fee is non-refundable)
- 0% refund after season officially starts

Refunds also issued under the following circumstances subject to review by the board of directors.

- Injury
- Relocation
- Unable to be placed on a team

If the PTAA Organization incurs any fees related to disputes or refunds, PTAA will add these fees to the players account online or final refund amount.

## **Baseball/Softball Approved Equipment**

## PTAA recommends the following MANDATORY equipment for its players ages (3 to 6)

- 1. Glove
- 2. Athletic shoes/cleats optional
- 3. Shorts/pants optional
- 4. T-Ball Bat
- 5. Helmets provided by coaches/own helmet optional.

# PTAA recommends the following MANDATORY equipment for its players ages (6+)

- 1. Fielders Glove
- 2. Cleats
- 3. Sliding shorts, athletic supporters, and a cup. Catchers are required to wear a cup. No catcher can catch without a cup.
- 4. Chest Guard. Pitchers are required to wear a chest guard in order to pitch. No pitcher can pitch without a guard.
- 5. Bat Only USA stamped bats up to 2 5/8 and wood bats are allowed. Any other bat is not allowed.

## PTAA recommends the following OPTIONAL equipment for its players ages (6+)

- 1. Batting Helmet PTAA Provides coaches with helmets if needed by players.
- 2. Equipment Bag
- 3. Mouth Guard
- 4. Sunglasses
- 5. Batting Gloves
- 6. Water Bottle
