Help Guide

Pitch Count Overview

- Shade the box for each FIRST PITCH thrown to EVERY BATTER. This allows us to properly record a pitcher's threshold.
- Mark every pitch thrown with an X or a / mark.
- Circle the last pitch thrown for each half-inning.
- You will be keeping the pitch count for both teams each game.
- When a pitcher is within ten (10) pitches of their Daily Maximum, you should give a courtesy warning to the Head Coach of that pitcher's team.
- After the game is completed, write the final score at the top of your sheet and turn in your pitching record to a Tournament Director.
- When a team is playing in more than one game per day, they may put in a pitcher in multiple games. If this occurs, the pitchers pitch count for additional games will pick up where they left off in the previous game until they are pulled or reach their Daily Maximum.
