NOTES	<p>Camp Updates – Rueben reported approx. 54 football signups for our 4/23/22 camp. Not too many coaches are available, maybe 2. He said 4 high school kids said they would help with set up which is not too much since first camp, cones stepovers. Russell stated he would be there for the first two sessions to help coach. He will bring a tent, table, square and registration forms for both fall season and the camp/clinic for drop in. 9U 10-11am, 12U 11:30-12:30, 14U 1-2pm. During breaks between ages, jerseys and helmets will be fitted to get an idea of fit. Monique will be available at the front for registration and meet and greet from 10-2. Kelly will be available from 9:30-12 and return at 1pm when Russell needs to leave. Tamee will be available from 9-11 then after cheer clinic, 1:30pm. Tamee asked about any COVID rules on us able to bring water to have in case. It is now allowed and Kelly offered to bring a case. Monique volunteered to make laminated sheets with payment info on them. The plastic bin with that stuff in it is at storage. Regina asked about reminders being sent for registered participants. All agreed and Rueben is going to do them for all league registrants for the camp/clinic.</p> <p>Athletic Director – Need to work tackle registration. He said he will be working on 14U team roster and contact to see who will be returning. There is a soft schedule EBYFC has put together that he will be sending to all. Right now we are slated for 4 home and 4 away games in the 8 week season. Rueben reported there is another league out there poaching kids from San Jose, San Leandro and Hayward leagues, the West Coast Islanders. They used to be a spring league and now they are doing fall.
