NOTES	<p>Meeting Minutes – Minutes for the 9/14 meeting were discussed Bree motioned to approve and Regina seconded. Vote 8 Yes 1 Abstained</p> <p>Athletic Director - 12U game is being held on 10/1 in Oakley and Rueben will be leaving to attend the game. All others are home games. We all need special awareness with this team.</p> <p>Lots of outstanding registration monies are still due. Rueben to initiate and oversee getting the money paid with participants families. Kelly to assist. \$285 additional uniform monies were requested for 2 uniforms for new participants. It was asked if these late adds had paid registration and they have not. A discussion was that the registration fee should be reduced since they started late and was decided the registration was to cover the cost of the uniforms at minimum. Playoffs are still in question.</p> <p>Kelly - \$1300 are needed now for nameplates on jerseys. No vote was made</p> <p>Steve P – Mentioned having spirit wear for the league for sale at flag.</p> <p>Finances – Financials a big topic of conversation. Need to get a better feel on what spending is still required, outstanding invoices, total monies owed Treasurer duties need to be transferred to current treasurer.</p> <p>Regina handled the cash monies after arriving on the 9/17 game. She will be providing totals once the numbers can be pulled from PayPal and Venmo which she has no access to as yet. Regina will be using that cash money to pay for our referees and EMT for the 10/1 game. Envelopes with amounts requested from Kelly will be provided to Kelly to pay as required.</p> <p>Regina to get the change required for the 10/1 day as we ran out a couple of times at our 9/17 game.</p> <p>Fundraising – Two fundraisers are starting, Snap Raise which provides 80% of total amount donated and 20% fee to Snap Raise. This runs for one month, 9/28-10/28. Double Good Popcorn is starting on 10/4 ends 10/8. Kelly sent a league email to all participants with fundraising information listed. They are to each set up their own store. Large discussion on league vs team fundraising. No final decision was made as the way monies are being dealt with right now, all goes into one. Team fundraising was decided, earlier in the year, to be \$100 per participant X amount of participants per</p>



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team and some fundraisers would help the families and kept track of to ensure all fulfilled the \$100 and other fundraisers would be directly for the league with nothing applied to the team/individuals that raised it, a direct league donation. Specific direction of how we will handle it unknown. We advised participants these two fundraisers will help towards the \$100 commitment.

Game Day 10/1 – Volunteers are hard to find. Monique working on the volunteer schedule to send to cheer. We only have three games at home so changing the time for games at 10AM, 12PM, 2PM. We will be locking the weigh in gate once weigh ins are done for each team to prevent people from not paying gate fees. People on the field sideline continues to be a problem not only at home but away games. We all agree we have to get a better handle on it. Maybe enforce badges only. Monique mentioned she has made some additional field assistant badges. Discussed players on the sidelines running through the cheer lines. Gina asked Rueben to instruct players that is not allowed. We are going to use both speakers to help the visiting side hear all announcements. Monique mentioned the incoming players to the next game need to be handled better and asked that they all report to the area outside the fence by the park side goal post. Rueben agreed and will start that this week.

10/15 & 10/22 Games – Homecoming game has been changed to 10/22 from 10/15. No motion was made and the vote count did not add up, not all votes were counted. Potential items to discuss for homecoming is the food, the use of the mechanical bull used last year, if we have a King & Queen. We will have four games at our last two home games and discussed trying to add some time after 5 by a minimum of one hour. Monique is working with COF to see if we can. She will report back once known.
