Announcements and Updates

- Our online registration program now has a translation feature to any language.
- Recreation futsal has been highly popular for the 2019 winter season. We are considering a summer futsal program as well, keeping the price at \$50 a player.
 - Future offerings should expand to include older players as well.
 - Referees are not currently futsal certified since we play with modified futsal rules.
- Staff updates submitted.

 - Coaches need to be prepared to pull player cards before the spring season for those players whose families are not working to address the balances.

 - The field coordinator would be in charge of getting volunteer assistance from scholarship recipients and would track these volunteer hours.
- Discussed VSA expansion of partnership with Culpeper.
 - This would require rebranding but would bring more experienced coaches to
 Culpeper and more resources for the club.
 - Matt will come and make a presentation of what it could look like before the next
 Board Meeting so there is time to consider our options before the vote.
 - The Richmond Kickers and Castle, NC are good examples of what this could look like for our club.
- March 16, there will be a Recreation and Travel Coaches meeting. This day will be combined with the Spring Field Day.
 - Field Day will be a day to get the goals in place and the fields ready for play.
- Sponsorships needed from area businesses who want to market their business.
