My goal is to market Culpeper to visiting travel and recreational teams and families when they come to visit us to play. The sponsors would also be exposed to our local teams and families that attend games.

Objectives:

- · Get sponsors for Culpeper Soccer Club
- · Have visiting teams/families go into town after/before their games
- Put up signs/banners to advertise our sponsors/businesses/Culpeper

Advertising our sponsors would encourage local businesses to sponsor Culpeper Soccer Club because it would 1.) expose them to a large audience of visiting teams and families and 2) give these teams a place to go after their game, or 3.) plan a trip on another visit.

Benefits:
