

- All fields will be modified for the **Spring 2016** to conform with new guidelines, to include retreat line where appropriate
- Recreation League:
 - Implement revised small sided games in **Spring 2016** for the following age groups:
 - U6: 4v4; U10: 7v7; U12: 9v9
 - All other age groups remain the same
 - Age Groups will change from Aug-Sept to Jan-Dec birth year for the Fall 2016 season
 - Players requesting to play up in order to remain with previous age group/team will be allowed
- Academy:
 - Age Groups will change from Aug-Sept to Jan-Dec birth year for the Fall 2016 season
 - Players will be allowed to play-up in order to remain with current rostered team
 - All NEW players will tryout and play for appropriate birth year
 - Implement U11 Academy Extended program in Fall 2016
- Travel:
 - Age Groups will change from Aug-Sept to Jan-Dec birth year for the Fall 2016 season










Culpeper Soccer Club

Reason: Parents feel cost of program is too high


- We must communicate the cost/benefit breakdown – must convince family the price is worth it


