- \$300 league fees; \$500 Coach payment; \$300 Technical Directors
- Tournament Cost \$1000
- Total Cost \$2100/12 team roster = \$175 per player plus \$130 uniform cost = \$305 per player

Classic Fees for other counties

U8 (8 Players per team) Ref- \$30 Medals -\$16.00 -T-Shirts - \$80 Total \$126 per team/\$15.75 per player

U10 (10 players per team) Ref- \$79.50 Medals -\$20.00 -T-Shirts - \$100 Total \$199.50 per team/\$19.95 per player

U12 (14 Players per team) Ref- \$102 Medals -\$28.00 -T-Shirts - \$140 Total \$270 per team/\$19.29 per player

U14 (18 Players per team) Ref- \$111 Medals -\$36.00 -T-Shirts - \$180 Total \$327 per team/\$18.17 per player

U14 (18 Players per team) Ref- \$135 Medals -\$36.00 -T-Shirts - \$180 Total \$351 per team/\$19.50 per player

I charged the other teams \$2 toward the medals per player and \$10 per T-shirt per player the actual cost are \$3.50 for the medals and \$6.50 per T-shirt so we will make money off of that. My recommendation is to charge each player \$20.00.









Overall Satisfaction with CSC














Overall Quality of Coaching


Findings:

Game Schedule



Action Items to Address Concerns



- Continued participation in the Inter-County League
- Seek to add U16 Recreation Age group
- Re-evaluate recreation team formation process to include future use of ride share option
- Properly document recreation rostering procedures
- Post financial information monthly on website
- Monthly newsletter from Board
- Hold Coaching Clinics regularly
- Post position descriptions on website
- Release important dates earlier on calendar
- Improve planning efforts
- Offer regular/annual referee courses
- Increase practice facility in order to accommodate more practice schedule requests
- Improve information on registration website
- Continue to promote NSCAA Level 1 Diploma course to recreation coaches (currently available for free)
- Reimbursement for education/licenses
- Pre-season coaches meeting
- Distribution of coaching manual
- Regular coaching clinics and courses
- Mentoring program for first time recreation coaches
