 - \$7000 operating budget for D5. This covers all operating expenses of the district. Dues were increased from \$300 to \$310 per town. The softball coaches clinic was \$100 and baseball coaches clinic was \$212 cost to Berlin Little League. Sharing cause we want to send more people to clinics.
