
CODE OF CONDUCT

The Perth Amboy Red Raiders Youth Football League Inc. has been and continues to be committed to inspiring the youth of the community to practice ideals of health, citizenship, and character by means of a common interest in sportsmanship, fair play, and fellowship. This organization's policy promotes commitment in everything from education to conduct on and off the field. Unlawful or misbehavior will be halted as soon as reasonably possible after discovery. Members (any participant in this organization) who violate the organization's policy will be disciplined.

To ensure that any violations of the Code are promptly and effectively investigated and any necessary corrective or disciplinary action is undertaken as soon as possible, the Coaches Committee and/or the Executive Board has been established as the Compliance Committee. Disciplinary action can range from suspension to expulsion from the organization.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. FIGHTING

Fight of any kind will not be tolerated. This policy applies to incidents during activities of this organization or outside.

2. USE OF PROFANITY AND/OR DISCRIMINATORY LANGUAGE

Every member has the right to participate in this organization free of discrimination or harassment.

3. APPEARANCE

All members will be required to maintain a proper appearance while in attendance at an organizational event.

4. CONDUCT ON AND OFF THE FIELD

All members will be required to conduct themselves in a sportsmanship-like manner. No disrespect to coaches and staff will be tolerated.

5. SUBSTANCE ABUSE

The Perth Amboy Youth Football League will not tolerate the use, possession, sale, or purchase of illegal drugs or the abuse of alcohol by its members.

6. SCHOOL WORK

All players, cheerleaders, and mascots are required to maintain good standards within the school.

7. ABSENTEEISM

All members must attend all practices in order to participate in games.
