PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Players shall conduct themselves in a proper manner at all League functions. Disrespect, bad language, physical altercations or insubordination will be met with appropriate action, up to and including disciplinary action.
- Players shall abide by their Coaches decisions regarding game positions, practices and playing strategies.
 Do not argue openly with your Coach over their decisions. They run the team.
- Players are responsible for promptness to all games, practices, team events or other special events.
- Players are expected to keep their uniforms in good condition. Jersey's must be tucked in.
- Players must provide their own soccer ball, shin guards, water bottle and cleats.
 Please make sure your name is on all these items.
 A protective wear (shin guard and soccer cleats) are required for all players in the Catoctin Youth Association Soccer Club CYASC. Failure to wear proper protective gear will forfeit the rights of the player to participate in a game or practice.
- During a game, players are NOT allowed to leave the field without the Coaches permission.
- Players are expected to participate in all clubs functions and fundraising events, unless the parent(s) opt out of the activity.
- Players shall be at all practices, games, team functions and special events at the assigned time. It is your responsibility to notify your Manager ahead of time if you cannot make it on time, or at all.
- Players are expected to take proper care of all CYASC equipment used by them and their teammates and to treat all facilities with respect, i.e., benches, restrooms, fields, etc.
- It is the responsibility of every team to clean their practice area and field sideline at the end of every game or practice.
- For safety reasons, standing on benches will not be allowed at any time.





PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Players should cheer on their team in a positive way. Screaming or yelling negative words against the other team is not allowed.
- Players are not allowed to use electronic devices (cell phones, IPods' or other mobile devices) on the bench and/or sidelines during games or practices. If a player needs to contact their parent or guardian during a game or practice, the player must discuss with their Manager or Coach first.
- There is NO eating on the fields until half time break and end of games snacks.
- Players will be responsible for abiding by the prevention of bullying and/or harassment policies as outlined in the Catoctin Youth Association Soccer Club CYASC
