Game Day Duties and Responsibilities 2025 Regular Season

Home Team Responsibilities

- Scorekeeping: Provide the official scorekeeper.
- First Game of the Day: Responsible for placing necessary equipment (mounds, tees, etc.).
- Last Game of the Day: Responsible for raking the field after the game.
- Dugout Assignment: Always occupies the 1st base dugout unless otherwise specified.

Away Team Responsibilities

- Scoreboard & Pitch Count: Provide an operator for both the scoreboard and pitch count tracking.
- First Game of the Day: Responsible for marking the fields (batter's boxes, baselines, pitching circle).
- Last Game of the Day: Responsible for putting away all equipment (mounds, tees, etc.).
- Dugout Assignment: Always occupies the 3rd base dugout unless otherwise specified.

Shared Responsibilities

- **Clean-Up:** Each team is responsible for cleaning up their respective areas, including dugouts and spectator stands, before leaving the fields.
- Score & Pitch Count Verification: Immediately following the game, the Head Coach of each team must verify the official score and pitch counts.

Warm-Ups & Batting Cages

- Batting cages are reserved for the next teams scheduled to play.
- No team shall warm up on any part of the field while a game is in progress, regardless of division.

Walk-Up Music Policy

Walk-up music is allowed under the following conditions:

- DOES NOT interfere with scheduled game start times.
- **DOES NOT** impede the general flow of the game.
- **DOES NOT** contain profanity.

All teams, coaches, and parents are expected to adhere to these guidelines to ensure a smooth and organized game day experience.
