**For LL Softball: a player's age is their age on December 31 of the year before the season starts*

Notes:

1. "LKLL Assessment" means: player must be assessed by the League as capable of participation at that level

2. LKLL Player Agent must be present for all ability assessments

3. All age exceptions must be approved by the LKLL President

4. Players have a right to challenge their determination of eligibility by exception. Determinations may be overruled by 2/3 vote of the Board.
