

Back-To-School Wiffleball Tournament

- ★ Teams will be 4-6 players
 - The teams can consist of all boys, all girls, or as co-ed
- ★ 4 Players in the field at a time
- ★ All players must bat
- ★ 4 Balls/3 Strikes/3 Outs
- ★ 45 Minute Games (we will finish any inning that started before the 45 minute mark)
- ★ **Pitchers Hand Rule-** a force out will occur at the lead base if the pitcher has the ball on the mound. Also any balls hit back to the pitcher, they have to field the ball cleanly before the runner gets to first base.
- ★ Pitchers can also act as any infield position for force outs.
- ★ **Play at the Plate Rule-** the runner is out at home if the ball is thrown home and hits the strike zone before the runner touches home.
- ★ **Peg Ball-** any runner struck by a thrown ball below the neck, not touching a base will be out.
- ★ There is no base stealing or leading off. Runners may tag up on a fly ball. Base runners will be called out if a batted ball hits them when they are off the base.
- ★ Bunting is illegal and will not be permitted.
- ★ Signed waivers are due August 24th at check in. Participants 17 and under must have a parent sign the waiver release form.
 - These waivers will be on our site for download or we will have copies at check in for players/parents to sign prior to their first game.

Power-Ups

- ★ **BIG RED BAT:** This bat can only be used by one player per inning. You will be able to purchase **RED** tickets(\$5/ticket) to use and must give the ticket to the umpire prior to the at bat.
 - This power-up is limited to **3** tickets per game.

★ **1 OUT:** Use this to give the offensive team 1 out to start the inning. You can purchase **BLUE** tickets(\$10/ticket) and must give the ticket to the umpire prior to the first pitch of the inning.

- This power-up is limited to **2** tickets per game.

★ **Runner At 1st:** Use this to start the inning with a runner on 1st, the last runner in the batting order(1st inning only) or last out of the previous inning. You can purchase **YELLOW** tickets(\$10/ticket) and must give the ticket to the umpire prior to the first pitch of the inning.

- This power-up is limited to **2** tickets per game.
