By saying yes to this form I understand that Poynette Cheer coaches can give my athlete pain reliever medicine (ibuprofen or advil) based on the directions on the bottle. I understand that coaches will not give pain medication to my athlete if an injury occurred during practices, games, performances, competitions or other cheer related events. I understand that athletes will give pain reliever medicine if your athlete needs it for headaches, menstrual cramps, or for an injury that occurred prior to practice or other cheer events. I understand that the Poynette Cheer coaches will have their athlete notify you or coaches will notify you when medication is taken.

By saying no to this form I understand that athletes cannot take any type of pain medication when under the Poynette Cheer coaches supervision. I understand that the only exception is when an athlete needs medical attention (epi pen, etc.).
