Uniform and Pom Equipment Agreement

I understand that I am responsible for getting my athletes cheer shoes that they only wear indoors for practices, competitions or other indoor cheer events. I understand that my athlete is borrowing uniform pieces, including but not limited to, shell top, skirt, turtle neck, briefs, poms and warm up jacket from PPYSA Cheer. I understand that all items borrowed to me unless otherwise noted by cheer directors need to be turned in on a given date or notify a director to find a time that works for both of you to turn it in. I understand that a security deposit of \$75 per cheerleader is required for any/ all borrowed items from the cheer program. I understand my athlete will not receive any uniform items until the security deposit is given.

A security deposit should be written as a check to PPYSA Cheer in a labeled envelope with my athletes name on it and given to a cheer director.

I understand that the uniform is for football games, parades, performances or competitions, unless program directors give permission for athletes to wear them elsewhere. I understand that the uniform should be washed cold and hung dry, I can use Oxiclean to spot clean the uniform but I should not bleach it. I understand that I am able to take in the uniform but I can not cut it or cause any damage. I understand that the borrowed uniform should be returned clean and in the same condition it was given. If failed to return by the given date or uniform is destroyed without notifying coaches the \$75 deposit will be cashed.
