## Pitch Count Rules

Pitching Rules apply to ALL Age Divisions

| Pitches thrown in a game | Required rest |
| :---: | :---: |
| 66 or more | 4 calendar days |
| $51-65$ | 3 calendar days |
| $36-50$ | 2 calendar days |
| $21-35$ | 1 calendar day |
| $1-20$ | none |

## Maximum Pitches Per Game

| Age Division | Max \# pitches thrown per game |
| :---: | :---: |
| $15-18$ | 100 |
| $13-15$ | 95 |
| $11-12$ | 85 |
| $9-10$ | 75 |

Required Rest defined: One Calendar Day of Rest $=$ Next Calendar Day
Example: On M onday a pitcher throws 35 or fewer pitches, he may pitch again on Tuesday, regardless of game start time.

The Starting Pitcher ONLY may return to the mound and resume his pitch count in the same game. All other relief pitchers may not return to mound after they are replaced by another pitcher.

Pitchers pitching 20 or less pitches may pitch again in the same day in another game. A pitcher may pitch to and retire a batter if his pitch count has not yet reached the maximum number of pitches. He must leave the mound after retiring that batter.
