Gibson Soccer Club started with one team, around 1970. The team traveled to outlying communities to find games. Soon, Malloch, Starr, Forkner, Figarden, Saint Anthony's, and Kratt formed clubs. Around 1980 they formed the Fig Garden Youth Soccer League. Many of the parents who are coaching now were players in the 1980's and 1990's. Our club now includes students from Gibson, Manchester Gate, Dailey, Bullard Talent, Baird, and Cooper.

We now offer recreational Soccer for all children born between 2004 and 2013. The Fig Garden Youth Soccer League involves nearly 2,000 children. The cost is \$100.00 and includes new uniforms (that your child keeps), a basic photograph package, and trophies. In addition, our volunteer coaches are provided equipment bags and education, training and support.

Our club offers two free soccer clinics on August 12, 2017 (U14-U10) and August 19, 2017 (U8-U5). In addition, we offer free Futsal training.

Our teams practice during the week (coach sets the schedule with input from parents). We have multiple practice sites in the Gibson area (northwest Fresno)

Our games are on Saturdays against the others soccer clubs in FGYSL and our playing partner leagues. We play at sites in the Bullard High School area. Even though we are a recreational league, both the FGYSL and Gibson Soccer have professional Directors of Coaching, the top referees in the area, and we are committed to a great family soccer experience.

As part of the FGYSL, we are also affiliated with Central California Soccer Alliance, the area's largest competitive soccer club.
