Insurance Procedures for Special Games w/ Non-Little League

Prior to our consideration of this application, the participating non-Little League team(s) must provide a copy of their General Liability and Accident Insurance policies that meet or exceed the limits of coverage required for all Little League programs as provided in Little League Regulation I(c)(7). For reference, the Accident policy must have a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per person per accident and the General Liability policy must have a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 single limit bodily injury and property damage as well as include coverage for claims involving 'athletic participants'. The General Liability policy must also list Little League Baseball, Incorporated as an Additional Insured.
